#### **CALL TO ORDER**

Supervisor David DiSalvo called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM at the Mount Morris Town Hall, located at 103 Main Street, Mount Morris.

#### **COURT CLERK**

Justice Ossont informed the board of Court Clerk Laurie Button's resignation and shared that he worked with Clerk Woodworth to advertise the vacant position.

Deputy Supervisor Huff recommended sending a letter of appreciation to Laurie Button for her service. The board agreed, and Justice Ossont expressed his gratitude.

Justice Ossont reported receiving numerous applications, although few were qualified. He recommended hiring Pamela Thurber, currently employed by the Wyoming County Court system in Family Court. She requested an annual salary of \$11,500 and was available to start immediately. Her proposed schedule includes Tuesday evening office hours and floating hours on Thursdays and Saturdays. Justice Ossont noted that the Office of Court Administration would need to be contacted to provide a computer for her.
